





River Park is a family. The class size and students to teacher ratio allows for a deeper connection, not only with each student, but also with his/her family.

Children are given the ability to develop a sense of ownership over their classroom environment. Our part-time schedule allows children to be children outside the structure of a full time school day.

The typical RPNS student is excited about the world around her/him, eager to grow from new experiences/challenges and supported by a family looking for a nurturing environment to foster a sense of self/independence.

Strong parent involvement defines the River Park community. Because the school is a co-operative, parent-run organization, the Director and Teaching Assistant are the only paid staff.


Parent Participation All administrative duties are carried out by the parents. Parents assist with field trips, organize fundraising, and serve on the Board of Directors. Parents also periodically assist in the classroom, generally, once every two to three months.



Our Location

River Park Nursery School is located at 212 East Capitol Street, NE, in Washington, D.C., in a light-filled classroom at the Lutheran Church of the Reformation (no affiliation). Two other school programs are located on the lower floors.

Classroom Safety

For the River Park Nursery School, community safety has always been our number one concern. While the beginning of the 2021 school year has been mostly outdoor learning, we have finally begun to have class indoors and are taking extra measures to keep our community healthy.



- Outdoor Drop-off with separate entrance and stairway for just our class
- Two FDA-approved air purifiers and up-to-date HVAC system
- Socially distanced snack time and lunch time
- Increased hand-washing and mask wearing
- Extra outdoor time and enhanced cleaning measures
